Five thousand New Living Translation (NLT): Africa Edition Bibles have been distributed to teens and pre-teens in Nigeria! 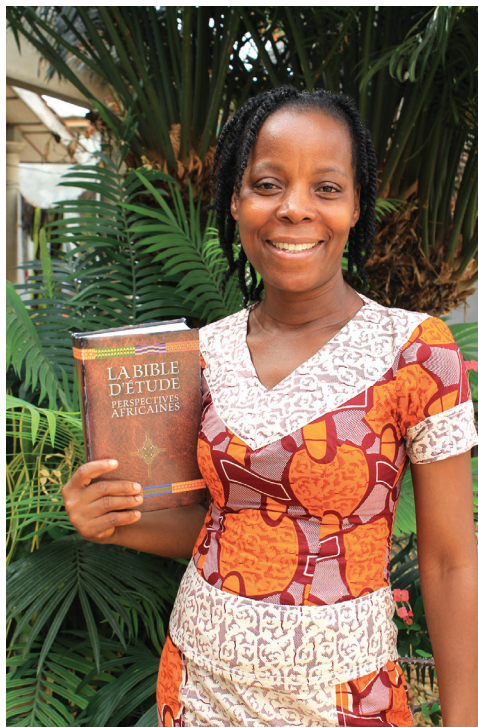

Oasis is Launching in New Countries in French-Speaking Africa

In many French-speaking countries like DR Congo, there are not enough Bibles for even the pastors. Since its launch, *La Bible d'étude: Perspectives Africaines*, or *La BEPA* has been widely acclaimed and embraced in Francophone Africa, with high demand for the first print run where 15,000 copies sold out immediately. The second print run of 10,000 copies have now almost all been distributed and therefore a third print-run is about to be scheduled.

At the People of the Book Church Growth Conference in Guinea, 150 pastors were equipped with *La BEPA*. This marks the first-ever shipment of these study Bibles to Guinea, making it a historic moment for the church. One pastor shared, "This Bible is more than a book; it's a treasure."

Oasis is Expanding the School Bible Initiative

Oasis markets its School Bible edition as an affordable Bible for secondary schools using the slogan, "God's Word through African Eyes." Since the launch of the program, over 100,000 Bibles have been distributed in schools in countries like Cameroon, Ghana, Kenya, Liberia, Malawi, Nigeria, South Africa, Uganda and Zimbabwe.

Highlighting a Few of the Many Oasis School Bibles Program Partnerships:

- LightWK provided NLT Bibles to hundreds of young Christians who live in Muslim communities in Northern Nigeria.
- Cyrus Cooper Smyth High School Ministry received NLT Bibles for high schoolers in Liberia.
- Focus Kenya's outreach to first-year university students provided with 1,000 NLT Bibles.
- Gateway Primary School in Zimbabwe gifted NLT Bibles to its graduating Class.
- Sight of God Ministries in Ghana distributed Bibles to seven schools to be used both in class and at home.
