Reaching Africa's Unreached—Strengthening the Church in Northern Uganda and South Sudan

17,720 Africa Study Bibles Delivered

In a region marked by instability, displacement, and rising tensions, the need for strong biblical foundations has never been more urgent.

This year, through our partner Reaching Africa's Unreached (RAU), an unprecedented investment was made to equip pastors across Northern Uganda, South Sudan, and the West Nile region with the Africa Study Bible.

Many of these pastors serve in remote, conflict affected areas where churches lack training, materials, and support. With the *Africa Study Bible* in hand, leaders can now apply Scripture through culturally relevant insights—helping them teach sound doctrine, disciple new believers, and strengthen churches that stand at the frontline of spiritual and social hardship.

RAU's growing resource center—serving Ugandan pastors, refugee camps, and Sudanese believers fleeing violence—ensures that Bibles, study tools, and theological books reach those who need them most. Together with ongoing training through RAU, these resources, including the *Africa Study Bible*, are empowering leaders to plant churches, reach unreached people groups, and multiply disciples in some of the hardest places to follow Christ.

In a time of great need, your support is placing God's Word into the hands of those carrying the hope of the gospel into the heart of East Africa's most vulnerable communities.


Compassion International Ghana – Celebrating 20 Years With Scripture

To commemorate two decades of ministry, Compassion International Ghana partnered with Oasis to produce 10,000 custom New Living Translation Text Bibles—our first-ever medium-sized edition. A milestone for them, and a new publishing milestone for Oasis.

More than 50,000 children living in poverty across 12 of the 16 states in Ghana will receive care, protection, and

nurturing, allowing them to learn, grow, play, and dream. Additionally, they will each receive a Bible to help them develop their faith, including 10,000 copies of the Oasis **New Living Translation: Africa Edition Bibles**.

Young Life and Scripture Union Partnerships – 25,000 Teens Equipped with Bibles

We joined **Young Life** and **Scripture Union** across three nations—to get God's Word into the hands of youth in active discipleship.

The goal was to distribute 25,000 school Bibles at an incredibly affordable cost of just \$5 per Bible. With this initiative, three nations were equipped—Ghana, Liberia, and Nigeria—with essential resources for spiritual growth.

Each Bible not only reached a teen but also played an instrumental role in their personal discipleship, ensuring that future leaders were strengthened in their faith.

By placing these Bibles in their hands, the faith of the next generation of leaders is being shaped and will make a lasting impact on their lives.





Seeds of Silence By Esme James



Equipping Pastors and Strengthening the Persecuted Church

In 2025, Oasis International launched two landmark initiatives with two partners that will multiply ministry impact across Africa for years to come. Together, these two transformative projects are equipping frontline pastors, strengthening persecuted Christians, and multiplying the impact of God's Word across the continent—thanks to the faithful generosity of partners like you.



Christian Association of Nigeria

The CAN Bible Project—a national movement with the Christian Association of Nigeria—began its bold mission to equip 500,000 Nigerian pastors, especially in rural and underserved regions, with the Africa Study Bible and essential discipleship tools.

With most pastors serving without resources or formal training, each study Bible becomes a lifeline—strengthening entire congregations, countering false teaching, and rooting ministry in Scripture and African wisdom.





Open Doors

The Open Doors Partnership introduced the *Persecution Study Bible*, a special edition of the *Africa Study Bible* in English and French, created for believers suffering for their faith.

From 2026 through 2028, 100,000 Bibles will be distributed across 31 of the most persecuted nations in Africa, offering courage, biblical insight on endurance, and testimonies of hope from regions where following Jesus costs everything.

Courageous believers in Northern Nigeria have refused to abandon their faith, even in the face of persecution. Their strength reminds us why Scripture is absolutely vital to grow the church.

"Through your faithful partnership, we have witnessed how the Africa Study Bible and other literature are restoring hope in communities devastated by conflict, natural disasters, and hardship. 

A Tribute to Those Who Strengthen the Church: Meet Prof Dr Abel Ndjerareou

As we close this year's impact report, we want to honour one of the quiet pillars of the church in Francophone Africa: Prof Dr Abel Ndjerareou, Oasis Board member, pastor, theologian, and mentor to thousands of Christian leaders across the Sahel.

Prof Abel would never call himself a pillar—so we will say it for him, humbly and with gratitude. His life embodies the heart of our mission: faithful leaders, serving in hard places, shaping the future of the church in Africa through the power of God's Word.



Over the years, Prof Abel has travelled through regions marked by political instability, religious tension, and deep spiritual hunger—from southern Chad to towns on the edge of the Sahara. There, he has witnessed pastors walk 20, 30, even 40 miles through mountains and bush just to receive training with *La Bible d'étude: perspectives africaines* or BEPA, the French version of the *Africa Study Bible*. In one seminar, a pastor opened Scripture and said, "I never understood it that way—now I see it clearly."

Stories like these remind us why we do this work—and why we are so thankful for partners like you who make it possible. Abel says it best in the video: "Thank you for your investment in people. God is using it in ways you cannot imagine."
